

2017 Cabernet Sauvignon

80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Petit Verdot

The 2017 Cabernet Sauvignon opens up with black currant, lilac, hickory and wet stones on the nose. The palate packs flavors of black cherry, chocolate torte, and nutmeg into a rich and chewy midpalate. This wine is incredibly focused on the long finish but lightens with a citrusy topnote at the very end.

Vineyard

100% Estate – Adelaida District, Paso Robles.

Fermentation

Destemmed and cold soaked for 8 days with daily pump-overs.

8-day fermentation with a mix of deléstages, pump-overs and punchdowns for cap management. 16-day total maceration.

Cooperage and Elevage

Aged for 22 months in 225L French oak barriques: 80% new, 20% neutral.

Bottling Date

3 July 2019

Bottled unfinned and unfiltered.
