46% Cabernet Sauvignon, 24% Merlot, 20% Malbec, 5% Cabernet Franc, 5% Petit Verdot

Seductive aromas of plum, anise, Calycanthus, cedar, and petrichor lure you in, while flavors of blackberry, cassis, fresh bay leaf, and violet keep you coming back for more. The palate is dense and tightly wound with a supple texture and polished tannins suggesting a beautifully long life ahead for this stunning blend...if you can keep your hands off it for now.

Vineyard:

100% Estate – Adelaida District, Paso Robles

Fermentation:

Destemmed and cold soaked for 7 days with daily pump-overs. 5-day fermentation with a mix of delestages, pump-overs and punchdowns for cap management. 12-day total maceration.

Cooperage and Elevage:

Aged for 34 months in 225L barriques: 60% new French oak, and 40% used French oak barrels.
