

**2019 Paradoxical**

*61% Cabernet Sauvignon, 34% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot,*

Opens with brightly pitched aromas of pie cherries, incense, rolling tobacco and freshly baked gingerbread. The elegant palate offers flavors of raspberry, menthol, nutmeg and red currant that evolve into a silky mid-palate. The graceful finish is framed with supple tannins and precise acidity.

**Vineyard:**

100% Estate – Adelaida District, Paso Robles.

**Fermentation:**

Destemmed and cold soaked for 5 days with twice daily pump-overs. 9-day fermentation with a mix of deléstages, pump-overs and punchdowns for cap management. 14-day total maceration.

**Cooperage and Elevage:**

Aged for 22 months in 225L French oak barriques: 33% new, 67% neutral.

**Alc:** 14.1%

**pH:** 3.47

**TA:** 6.7 g/l

**Bottling Date:** July 26th, 2021. Bottled unfined and unfiltered.
